## **Vehicle Storage**

This is a friendly reminder that per the HOA by-laws, vehicles such as motorhomes, travel trailers, boats, etc. cannot be stored on your property for longer than 48 hours at a time. However, they can be stored in your garage with the door closed.

These types of items also should not be stored overnight on the street per the City of East Lansing parking ordinance.

#### **Building Approvals**

It is that time of year when residents are planning projects such as decks, fences, sheds, playsets, etc.

Please remember that you must receive approval from the HOA architectural committee before beginning any improvement project on your property.

We also have an approval form that must be on file with the HOA before you begin work. A copy is attached for your reference.

#### Yard Waste Pick-Up

There are three options to contain yard waste for pick up by the City, including:

- 1. Purchasing City paper yard waste bags. They must weigh no more than 40 pounds when full.
- Use a rigid, 32-gallon plastic container or paper bag with a purchased City yard waste sticker attached.
- Bundled (with string or twine) with a City yard waste sticker attached.

Yard waste should be placed at the curb by 7:30am on Monday morning. You must request the Monday pick-up through the City's online collection request form or by calling the DPW at (517) 337-9459.

# 2019 Annual Dues

The invoices for annual dues were sent out on March 14th. We have maintained our current \$200/year for 2019. If you did not receive an invoice in the mail, you are set up to receive it via e-mail.

Payment for invoices was due by April 13, 2019. A \$10 late fee has now been assessed to all accounts that are unpaid. Property liens will be issued in the fall on any unpaid 2019 dues at an additional charge of \$100.

#### **Precaution is the Best Defense**

The neighborhood and its surrounding area is experiencing vehicle break-ins at night. Unfortunately, in most of these break-ins the vehicle's doors were not locked.

The ELPD informed us that the best defense is to not provide the opportunity. Lock your vehicle doors and keep valuables out of sight. Also, the same goes for our houses – keep your doors and windows locked at night or when you are away.

#### **Mail Boxes**

Recently there have been reports of possible "check washing" in the neighborhood. Check washing is the process of erasing details from checks to allow them to be rewritten, usually for criminal purposes such as fraudulent withdrawal from the victim's bank account. These checks seem to be taken from resident's mail boxes that had mail placed in the box during the overnight hours.

The HOA has alerted our ELPD liaison about this. He has encouraged anyone who has this happen to them, to file a police report. Also, if you happen to have any camera footage (ring door bell, etc.) of the possible perpetrator, to pass that along to the police as well.

## **Tree Trimming**

The City of East Lansing has stated that if a homeowner is unable to keep their individual street side trees maintained, they will help with trimming them at no charge. Many street side tree branches in the neighborhood are interfering with City vehicles such as trash trucks.
