Street Trees

As spring is here, Please check the branches on your street trees and trim any that are not in



accordance with City of East Lansing Ordinance Sec. 48-62. Trimming:

... any tree shall be kept so trimmed that there shall be a clear height of not less than 12 feet above the portion of the surface of the [street] used for vehicular traffic, and not less than seven feet above all sidewalks, unobstructed by branches; and no such person shall fail to remove all dead branches or stubs on such tree or trees which are, or may become, a menace to travelers on a street. (Code 1994, ch. 36, § 3.15) **Please trim your tree branches ASAP**

Beware of blocking sidewalks while parked in your driveway! It was brought to the attention of the HOA that the City of East Lansing is ticketing cars parked over the sidewalk. To avoid paying a fine make sure when you are parked in your driveway the sidewalk is not blocked.

Floodplain Update

May 2011 the In Federal **Emergency Management Agency** designated a portion of the HN neighborhood to be in a 100-year floodplain. For homes on the south side of Anhinga, on the east side of Kiskadee, and homes adjacent to HN Park (and a few others), a portion of the backyards may be in the flood plain, but it is almost certain that the homes are not and can be excluded from the flood plain. There is no need to buy flood insurance. If you have purchased flood insurance you

may be entitled to a refund. Even if you want to purchase flood insurance, the insurance is much cheaper if your home is excluded from the flood plain. Fourteen HN homeowners have already successfully hired а survey company to remove their home from the floodplain. Sec. 36-85. Placement of containers for collection

...provided, further, that no person shall place refuse containers in the public right-of-way for collection by the city before 8:00 p.m. of the day preceding the regularly scheduled collection day,...and the occupant(s) shall not allow the refuse containers to remain in the public right-of-way past 10:00 a.m. on the day following the date the refuse is collected.

Rentals

- Any rental of a Hawk Nest home must be approved by both the City of East Lansing and the Hawk Nest Board.
- An owner living in an E. L. home can rent out only one room to only one tenant. This room rental must be approved by the City of East Lansing.

Sec. 38-127. - Snow, ice, rubbish or other obstructions

No person having the care, either as owner or occupant of any house, building, or lot, shall fail to maintain the sidewalks adjoining the property in accordance with the following standards:

- Rubbish, including broken bottles and glass, filth, obstruction, or other nuisance shall be removed within 24 hours or as specified by chapter 14 of this Code if the provisions therein are applicable and require sooner removal.
- (b) Ice shall be removed within 12 hours after the same has formed or salt, sawdust, sand, or other abrasive shall be strewn thereon.
- (c) Snow that accumulates before noon on a sidewalk, as the result of a snowfall, shall be cleared from the sidewalk so as to afford

reasonably unimpeded passage by the public by midnight of that date and any snow accumulating after noon on a sidewalk, as a result of a snowfall, shall be cleared to the same extent by midnight of the following day.

 (d) Snow that accumulates on a sidewalk as the result of plowing or drifting shall be cleared from the sidewalk so as to afford reasonably unimpeded passage by the public within 24 hours.
